The majority of the ingredients in the **Natural Pets Online Cat Nutrition Supplement** are from Certified Organic sources because a little really does go a long way. This supplement will help improve your pet's health, on the inside and out!

The word 'Organic' signifies that an ingredient is produced without the use of pesticides, herbicides, synthetic fertilizers, bio-engineering or ionizing radiation. This is a very important factor when you look at the overall health of your cat, and keeping them away from as many chemicals as possible, which can potentially lead to compromising their immune system, and lead to dis-ease.

These ingredients are especially chosen as recommended by holistic veterinarians such as [Dr Richard Pitcairn](#), [Juliette deBaircali Levy](#) and Dr Susan Wynn. Preparation of the ingredients follows the principles of Reiki and Dr Emoto's Hado effect².

Ingredients:

Kelp – iodine, calcium, minerals, vitamins B, D, E & K, & amino acids

Organic Barley Grass – selenium

Lecithin (non GMO) – kidney & liver cleansing, brain function

Organic Coconut – anti-inflammatory

Organic Garlic – anti-cancer properties, blood purifier & natural antibiotic

Organic Sesame Seeds – magnesium & zinc

Vitamin C (Ester C) - antioxidant

Organic Rosemary – antioxidant, anti-inflammatory, flatulence.

Organic Slippery Elm Bark – digestive tract, nutritive

Organic Lemongrass – anti-inflammatory, urinary tract

Organic Parsley – antioxidant, vitamins & minerals

Organic Cranberry – urinary tract

Organic Catnip – general tonic, diabetes

Organic Goldenseal – immune system, infections (if required)

Organic Astragalus (if required)

Feeding Instructions

Gradually introduce your cat to their new food over 7 days. Start with $\frac{1}{4}$ **teaspoon** per day and work up to the normal dose of $\frac{1}{2}$ **teaspoon per 10kgs** (maximum 1 teaspoon) per day. This supplement is best mixed in with Acidophilus Yoghurt (for palatability and antibiotic properties). Alternatively, sprinkle it on top of their dinner, mixed in with a little water. Gradually reduce the number of days you feed the supplement to approximately twice a week.

NOTE: It is recommended that this supplement be fed to cats before the mating, not during pregnancy, and not whilst lactating.
